

# GUIDE TO COURT

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to court starting.
- Victim Services will meet you at the court house at the agreed upon place. You will stay together in a private room or area until called to testify.
- After you testify you will be excused from the court room. The Crown Prosecutor will meet with you prior to leaving.
- Victim Services can also accompany you to the offenders sentencing.
- You can request updates about the offenders status after the trial.

## VICTIM SERVICES ROLE

- Explain and support you through the process
- Provide court orientation
- Provide updates on where court will be held
- Prepare you for a possible testimony
- Accompany you to court
- Follow up and explain what happens after court

The role of this support is to help individuals who have witnessed a crime and are required to go to court through emotional assistance and procedural preparation.
